Designation: Training and Placement Opportunities Officer, YTC, Satara

The session was organized for the students of MCA-II. Prof P.S Gade welcomed the speaker Mr. Tushar Shende Sir. Mr. Tushar Shende has been working as Training and Placement Opportunities Officer in the YTC Campus for more then 4 years. A total of 35 students attended the lecture.

Mr. Tushar Shende Sir introduced the sessions and encouraged students to think of a business rather just opting for a salaried job. To promote a vibrant business community and generate employment, the Government of India provides a host of subsidies and incentives for business. For any entrepreneur managing a startup or an established business, it is important to know about these subsidies and incentives – so that these subsidies are availed while incurring capital expenditure to reduce capital cost, lessen interest burden and achieve break-even faster. While mentioning the economic constraints he listed the several problems encountered by Entrepreneurs.

- Lack of adequate infrastructure
- Locations of supporting offices for projects
- Lack of relevant information and knowledge e.g.
 - · Managerial skills and technical now how,
 - Market intelligence, etc.

TO overcome these issues the Government has made provisions of incentives like availability of power, concessional finance, capital investment subsidies, transport subsidies, etc. aims at eliminating such constraints and promote entrepreneurship. Government provides support to entrepreneurs in the following ways:

 Training: Trainings aims at improving the entrepreneurial skills. Basic training varies from product to product but will necessarily emphasise on sharpening of entrepreneurial skills.

In this regard central and state go chiment sechnical institutions provide need based technical training.

- Entrepreneurship development programmes are conducted by many government organizations and non-government institutions.
- Promotional schemes:
 - MSMEs are accorded highest priority.
 - For their development conducive policies and schemes are formulated and implemented.
 - Government provides land and sheds on actual cost basis with appropriate infrastructure.
- · The government has designed the special schemes for:
 - Quality upgradation
 - Common facilities
 - Entrepreneurship development, and
 - Consultancy services at minimal charges.

Schemes of State Governments:

- The state governments also provide technical and other support services to MSME through their directorate of industries and district industries centre.
- In general all the state governments extend support of following types:
 - a) Deferment/ suspension of sales tax.
 - b) Power subsidy
 - c) Capital investment subsidies to new enterprises established in some selected districts.
 - d) Margin money/seed capital assistance schemes.
 - e) Priority in providing power connection/water connection.
 - f) Technical and consultancy support.





NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

OBJECTIVES

Responsibilities of IWCSC:

Both parties agree that IWCSC shall provide the following support to YTC:

- Planning and execution of support for various programs at YTC as per necessity
- Conducting programs through Guest lecturesand carriying out activities as per IWC avenue decided for the concerned year.

Responsibilities of YTC:

Both parties agree that YTC shall provide the following support to IWCSC:

- Planning and execution of programs at YTC as per agreed procedures and suggestions
- Providing adequate and reliable infrastructure and hospitality
- Performing supportive documentary work of the activities at YTC
- Securing coordination and other supports provided by IWCSCrelevant to the relevant activities.

Execution and Operational Review :

- YTC and IWCSCwill review the operations of the program yearly. The purpose of
 the review shall be to assess the planning and operations of the program including, but
 not limited to its quality, timeline, performance, and progress. The subject of
 expansion and amplification of the scope of this MoU will also be discussed during
 the review meeting.
- Each year the office bearers of IWCSC are subjected to change however it is expected that the same MOU will be considered to be continued.

General Provisions:

- The parties shall discuss and finalize the detailed scope of work to be performed by each party for each assignment and agree on all considerations for the same.
- Except as agreed above neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the parties.
- 3) The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation identified in this MoU shall be subject to the availability and convenience of faculty, research scholars, students, and infrastructure facilities at the parties' workplace.

This MoU is not intended to create a relationship such as a partnership, joint venture, or agency. Neither party may act in a manner that expresses or implies a relationship other than independent contractor, nor bind the other party. Participation in this MoU shall not prevent either party from entering into similar MoUs with other institutions.

Validity:

Unless extended by the Parties in writing this MoU shall remain valid and effective for a period of Three (03) years from the date of execution, hereof, and can be extended for a further period of Two (02) years. 


Fig. I: Proposed innovation model
